Emergency Medical Technician.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Under general supervision, performs skilled and technical work in operating an approved Emergency Medical Service unit rescuing victims and administering emergency medical care to patients on site and while in route to hospitals. Work involves responding to the scene of emergency and non-emergency calls, applying necessary medical treatment to sick or injured persons, and transporting persons to a medical facility. Performs in accordance with established emergency medical procedures and protocols approved by the local medical director at the NC EMT level and must exercise considerable independent judgment to assess conditions of patients and administer appropriate medical treatment.

This position is a 24 hour shift position working A,B,C Shift patterns.
Candidates will be expected to successfully complete written, practical and physical evaluations.

Qualifications

- Credentialed by the North Carolina Office of Emergency Medical Services as an Emergency Medical Technician outlined in 10A NCAC 13P .0502
